HIGHLIGHTS DURING FISCAL YEAR 2024

August 20, 2023, LEGO Competition

The 3rd Annual LEGO Competition was held on August 20, 2023. The Museum hosted 20 participants who were selected at random. There were two different age ranges of 6-8 and 9-11. Prizes were awarded to first, second, and third place winners.

November 29, 2023, Member Preview Night: Energy/Energía

Museum members were invited to preview the Museum's newest exhibit before the public. The first 100 members were gifted a gallery branded lanyard with light up medallion.

December 31, 2023, Noon Years Eve

We held our Noon Years Eve event on December 31, 2023. This event was open to both members and general admission for exclusive free play, themed crafts, dance party, and countdown to noon with balloon drop. The Museum offered attendees light snacks and bottled water.

February 3, 2024, Touchdown Tailgate

The Museum held its first daylong member-only event on Saturday, February 3, 2024. Free football themed crafts, lawn games and story time were available for members in DISCOVERY Hall. Members also had the opportunity to purchase a face painting add on and special retail merchandise from the snack bar.

May - September 2024, Summer Family Fun Pass

Museum visitors were given the option of purchasing a discounted membership that was valid May 21 – September 2, 2024. Families had the option to upgrade their membership to a yearlong membership by paying the difference.

June 15, 2024, Ice Cream Social

Our annual Ice Cream Social event was held on June 15, 2024. With Walmart and Blue Bell as our sponsors, we were able to provide our members with complimentary ice cream. The Museum hosted a slime workshop and free ice cream themed crafts.

Each year, DISCOVERY Children's Museum hosts three signature fundraising events which allow us to share the magic of the Museum with supporters throughout the Southen Nevada community.

DISCOVERY honored the late Dr. Joe and Joan Lapan with the 2023 Great Friend to Kids Award. Their legacy continues through the "DISCOVERY On Wheels: House Calls" program, now expanding to middle school students in 2024-2025 school year. With nearly 300 guests, the event raised a record-breaking \$452,000, supporting the Museum's programs, exhibit maintenance, and outreach initiatives.



Superhero Day | Saturday, July 22, 2023

Worldwide Day of Play | Saturday, September 30, 2023

DISCOVERY hosted its first Worldwide Day of Play event on Saturday, September 30, 2023. As a day that is dedicated to experiencing the joy of learning through play, this global event focuses on getting children and their families active. Visitors enjoyed special programming that included customizing dancing ribbons, decorating musical instruments, designing playful puppets, challenging friends and family in a variety of interactive games, engineering lofty designs at our Imagination Playground, and becoming a human spirograph. Visitors also enjoyed a special slime making workshop in our DISCOVERY Lab gallery. **Total Attendance: 843 visitors**

National Chemistry Week Celebration | Sunday, October 15, 2023

DISCOVERY partnered with the American Chemical Society to offer a day celebrating chemistry! Children and their families enjoyed demonstrations and activities such as building a battery, creating natural dyes, explored sublimation with dry ice, launching rockets and experimenting with chemistry phenomena. Visitors also observed dazzling demonstrations including flames, color changes, awesome actions and reactions at our Patents Pending Science Bench. **Total Attendance: 591 visitors**

Flood Safety Event | Saturday, October 21, 2023

DISCOVERY Children's Museum hosted a Flood Safety Day in collaboration with the Regional Flood Control District where visitors participated in special programming including making Drainger Danger puppets, designing flood safety posters, engineering storm drain covers, learning how storm clouds release rain and observing how flash floods can be destructive.

Visitors also enjoyed making a replica state flag, designing a train fit for the Nevada Southern Railway and creating their own unique pair of damselfly wings. **Total Attendance: 922 visitors**

Girl Powered STEM Event | Sunday, October 29, 2023

In celebration of International Day of the Girl, DISCOVERY welcomed grades K – 8 students and their families to engage in STEM learning experiences. Participants enjoyed a special presentation by women in STEM speakers, including Dr. Taryn Bragg, Sunrise Children's Hospital Pediatric Neurosurgeon; Patricia Rodriguez, NV Energy Director of Demand Side Management, and Dr. Nina Mirzayan, Adaven Children's Dentistry Pediatric Dentist. Visitors also participated in STEM stations featuring circuitry and engineering challenges, and introductions to coding, 3D printing and CAD. 

DISCOVERY on Wheels: House Calls Founded by Dr. Joe and Joan Lapan

During FY2024 the DISCOVERY on Wheels: House Calls program continued to serve Clark County students within the Las Vegas valley and beyond. Although the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act would end in October 2023, the program was still offered FREE of charge for schools to reserve visits for the remainder of the calendar school year. Additionally, in September 2023, the DISCOVERY team started a collaboration with Smile Squad Kid's Dentistry & Braces for the Bright Smiles, Clean Bodies program. A Smile Squad team member would attend DISCOVERY on Wheels visits alongside the DISCOVERY facilitator and provide various dental hygiene tools and materials for students. during the lesson. The Smile Squad collaboration served 23 school and plans to continue into the following school year.

In March 2024, the DISCOVERY on Wheels team began facilitating visits at the Child Haven center. Visits are scheduled to continue through the end of 2024.

DISCOVERY on Wheels: House Calls also experienced much success during the summer months as well reaching children at Community Recreation Centers. Learning Academies, and childcare facilities.

DISCOVERY on Wheels: House Calls Founded by Dr. Joe and Joan Lapan

The DISCOVERY team participated in over 70 community events! This year received a grant from SAN MANUEL BAND OF MISSION INDIANS. This allowed DISCOVERY to build relationships with some of Southern Nevada's Native population through attending events organized by leaders and representatives of local Indigenous tribes and colonies. By attending these events our team was also able to increase their knowledge of Native culture and traditions so that we could incorporate authentic education into our activations and programming.

This year, in partnership with United Way of Southern Nevada, our outreach team distributed the "Play By The Rules" booklet at each community event with a bilingual or Spanish-Speaking audience.

Additionally, Family-Four Packs of complimentary passes, or a gift membership were also distributed to families via our outreach booth raffles. Collectively, we provided over \$6,000 of In-Kind admission to DISCOVERY Children's Museum.
